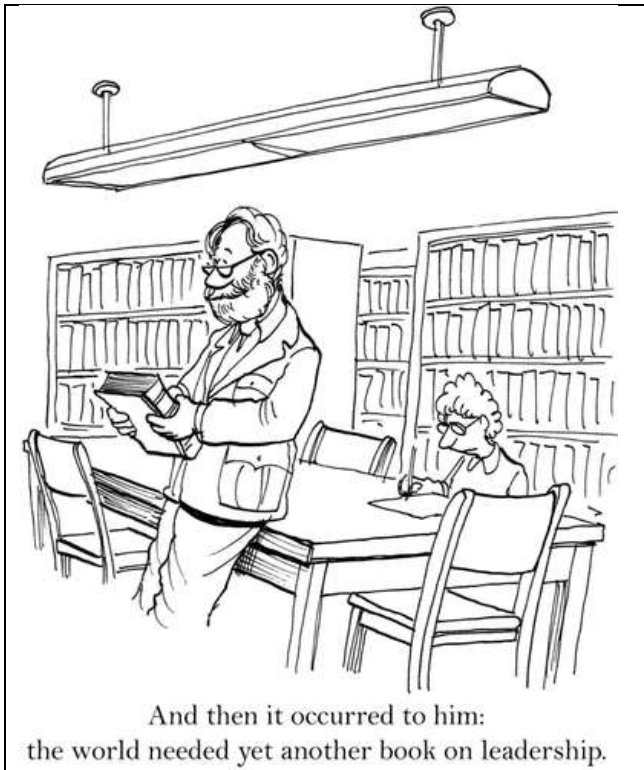

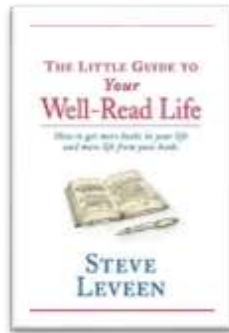

HOW TO READ A BOOK

The Little Guide to Your Well-Read Life How to Get More Books in Your Life and More Life from Your Books

“Give Yourself the Gift of Empty Shelves”

[Aug. 10, 2020] This is funny! Next month I'll begin the 15th year of publishing *Your Weekly Staff Meeting*. The first issue was August 28, 2006, and I recommended Jim Collins' easy-to-read 35-page booklet, *Good to Great and the Social Sectors*.

So after reviewing more than 450 books (some issues have highlighted multiple books), I took time to read a book about how to read a book!

“Do not set out to live a well-read life but rather *your* well-read life. No one can be well-read using someone else's reading list.”

Wham! Immediately, author and entrepreneur Steve Leveen lets you off the hook—no guilt. Just a boatload of ideas on navigating your own well-read life. The book features dozens of PowerPoint-worthy quotations, including this from Atwood H. Townsend:

**“Never force yourself to read a book that you do not enjoy.
There are so many good books in the world
that it is foolish to waste time on one that does not give you pleasure.”**

To uncover the books that will change your life (the big idea of the book), the author suggests you have two libraries:

- #1. The Library of Candidates (based on your List of Candidates)
- #2. The Living Library (your library of well-read friends)

Leveen did massive research and one-on-one interviews with readers and book clubs before writing this book. He notes that John Armato, a PR executive, “cherishes his growing Library of Candidates. When people ask him if he's actually read all those books, he asks if they've actually eaten all the food in their kitchen. ‘It is good to put up a supply of books; it increases the odds that you'll have what you want when you're hungry for it,’ he says.” Leveen adds: **“Give yourself the gift of empty shelves. Like an open road, they hold the promise of your future examined life.”**

The chapter, “Seizing More from Your Reading,” gave me several new ideas—and affirmed several of my best practices. “The advice-givers all agree that you should not

start by reading the first sentence of a book and then plow your way through to the end.” His practical suggestions (start at 35,000 feet and conduct three tours of the book) include this: “Then take a third tour, and read a few introductory and concluding paragraphs from each chapter. That is where most writers sum up their major points.”

When should you give up on a book? **“A few years ago I gave up on *Crime and Punishment*. I found it not enough crime and too much punishment.”** Generally, Leveen votes for the 50-page rule: “...if you don’t like it after fifty pages, close the book and move on.”

Where do you find the meat of a book? Usually in the middle, but don’t forget my rule-of-thumb for striking gold on page 25 also. In Leveen’s book on page 25, you’ll find his generous recommendations of other books on how to read a book, including a classic, *Good Reading: A Helpful Guide for Serious Readers*.

I ordered *The Little Guide to Your Well-Read Life* for the five scholars/grandchildren in my life. (Three are ready to begin their senior year in high school—whatever that might look like at Covid High.) Students and serious readers will appreciate Leveen’s “proven techniques for remembering” content. Example: In the 1940s, Ohio State University professor Francis Robinson conducted the psychological research that created the system, SQ3R: Survey, Question, Read, Recite, and Review.

One granddaughter keeps a list of the books she’s read. So far in 2020, she’s knocked off 130 books! She affirms Leveen’s suggestion: “Another way to help your long-term retention is by keeping a reader’s journal or annotated Bookography.” He also notes that “Some of the most satisfying reading of all is re-reading. The Bible is the most re-read book of all in the West.”

Every year, my friend and mentor, George Duff, re-reads Peter Drucker’s *The Effective Executive*. Be sure to read Jim Collins’ foreword to the 50th anniversary edition, “Ten Lessons I Learned from Peter Drucker.”

If you love books—and love the lifelong nourishment that good books deliver—you’ll feast on *The Little Guide to Your Well-Read Life* (123 delicious pages), including a tempting bibliography of 86 books. (I borrowed a few titles for my List of Candidates and my Library of Candidates.)

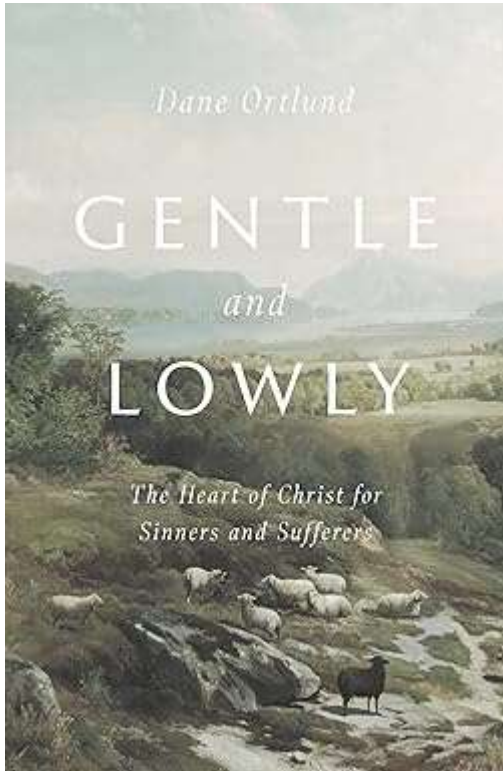
Footprint Leaver or Preservationist? Don’t miss the pros and cons of Footprint Leavers (those who write in books—I’m in the marginalia camp) and the opposing group, Preservationists (no writing allowed). Leveen received more than 2,000 responses to his blog on this Big Argument, including “A book unmarked is a book unloved.”

Also, learn why speed reading isn’t that important (the difference between reading speed versus thinking speed).

He quotes Mortimer Adler, coauthor of *How to Read a Book*: “Whereas a bookplate indicates financial ownership...writing in a book indicates intellectual ownership.” Leveen is encouraging. “If you have led an active reading life, your reading power at age eighty will tower over your reading power at age thirty.” And this: **“If you are not setting some books aside unfinished, you are not sampling enough books.”**

❑ 591. **Lead with Prayer: The Spiritual Habits of World-Changing Leaders**

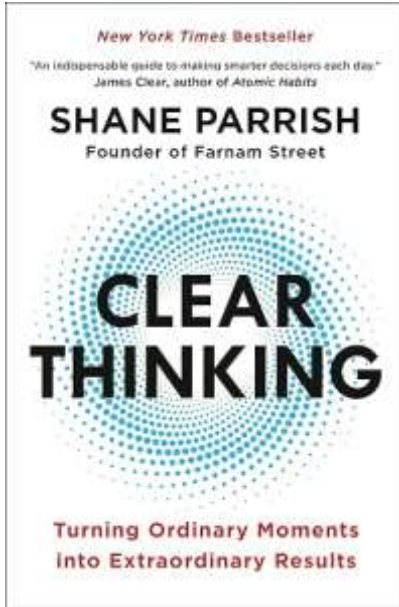
by Ryan Scoog, Peter Greer, and Cameron Doolittle

The author of *Clear Thinking* mentions this memorable story about former U.S. Secretary of State Henry Kissinger (1923-2023):

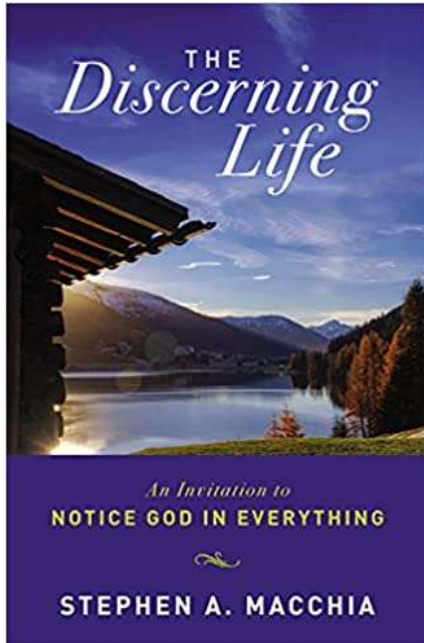
- “A staffer had drafted a memo and left it on Kissinger's desk for him to read. A while later, Kissinger approached him and asked if it was his best work. The staffer said no and rewrote the entire memo.
- The next day the staffer ran into Kissinger again and asked what he thought. Kissinger asked him again if this was the best he could do. The staffer took the memo and rewrote it yet again.
- The next morning, the same scenario played out, only this time the poor staffer stated that yes indeed it was his best work.
- Kissinger replied, ‘**Okay, now I'll read it.**’”

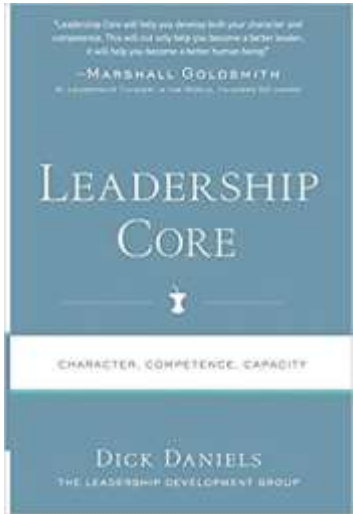

❑ 496. ***Experiencing God (2021 Edition): Knowing and Doing the Will of God***, by Henry Blackaby, Richard Blackaby, and Claude King

“Nowhere in the Bible does God promise to stop us from making mistakes!” The authors list four inappropriate ways for discerning God’s voice. (Even well-meaning people make these mistakes! Yikes!) These are serious mistakes—because people are misunderstanding what the Bible teaches. They include: “1) Asking for a miraculous sign, 2) Seeking a method, 3) The ‘name it and claim it’ method, and 4) Open and closed doors.”

We're talking about trust, believability and likeability—the emotional connection." Must-read: *You're Got to Be Believed to Be Heard: The Complete Book of Speaking...in Business and in Life*. Listen to the audio at Libro.fm—just 5 hours and 8 minutes.

❑ **FACTS = BOREDOM.** In his 107-page quick-read, *How to Deliver a TED Talk: Secrets of the World's Most Inspiring Presentations*, Jeremy Donovan warns: "If you would like to bore people to tears until they tear out their hair and claw their eyes out, then hammer them with facts for the entire 18 minutes of your TEDTalk."

❑ **PAINT A PICTURE.** Which sentence grabs you? "Deficits will badly affect the economy," or "Deficits will spread a subtle, devastating poison through the economic bloodstream." Even if you're not interested in deficits, the "poison" picture has arrested your curiosity. That's from the "Paint a Picture" chapter in Milo O. Frank's 128-page power book, *How to Get Your Point Across in 30 Seconds—or Less*.

Pearson served 11 years as the president/CEO of Christian Management Association (now called [Christian Leadership Alliance](#)). He also served as the president of Willow Creek Association, South Barrington, Illinois (a network of 12,000 churches worldwide, now called [Global Leadership Network](#)); was on the management team at [Willow Creek Community Church](#); and was the executive director of [Christian Camp and Conference Association](#), now based in Colorado Springs, Colorado, and known for many years as Christian Camping International/USA.

He's a graduate of Seattle Pacific University and Trinity Evangelical Divinity School and also served five years as the director of Christian education/camp director with the Midwest district of the Baptist General Conference, Chicago, Illinois, (now called Converge MidAmerica) and six years as the executive director of SAMBICA, a Christian camp and conference center on Lake Sammamish in Bellevue, Wash.

During John's 30 years as a nonprofit CEO (25 of those years leading three associations), he has been the publisher of two magazines, written more than 750 issues of various newsletters on management and ministry and more than 100 magazine columns on leadership and management ministry trends, including the "Management Rules of Thumb" series in the *Christian Management Report*.

He also led more than 50 regional, national and international conferences, and facilitated dozens of day-long CEO Dialogue roundtables. John served six years on the board of [ECFA](#) (Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability), was chairman of the presidential search committee (to replace a CEO/founder) as a board member for Interdev, and also served as a board member at Bakke Graduate University.

In 2006, Christian Management Association honored Pearson as the first recipient of the Ted Engstrom Award, named after Dr. Ted Engstrom (1916-2006), the president emeritus of World Vision. John also served on the Board of Directors of Christian Community Credit Union, including six years as board chair from March 2012 to March 2018. He is also a member and volunteer with The Barnabas Group Orange County.

John, and his wife, Joanne (who served as their company's COO), have been married for 56 years and they've had the privilege of traveling and/or teaching leadership, management and board governance in more than 50 countries. John and Joanne's son, Jason, also lives in San Clemente with his wife, Melinda. They are the parents of five children, including triplets. Jason also serves both nonprofit and for-profit organizations through his company, [Pearpod Media](#) (branding, digital, print, video).
